2nd Annual Pramberger Adult Piano Festival and Competition

Held at The King Center on October 9, 2004, Rockley Music Center sponsored the 2nd Annual Pramberger Adult Festival and Piano Competition. Over 50 professional and amateur adults performed and competed. All of the performers received a CD recording and a written evaluation of their performance by judges Zoe Erisman, Rich Italiano, Christelle Menth and Jan Spritzer. The Open category winner was Tad Koriath, performing the Beethoven Sonata, Op. 14#2 and the Chopin Nocturne in c minor, Op.42#1. Honorable mention in the open category was Peter Vavra.

The winning performance in the amateur category was by John Saxon, performing the Chopin etude Op.25#12, the Debussy Sarabande from Suite Pour le Piano, and the Prokofiev Sonata #7, 3rd Mvt. Honorable mention was Tyler Hudish. Prizes for the winning performances included use of a Pramberger grand piano for a year! The 3rd Annual Festival will be held in the spring of 2006 and again will be available for all pianists over the age of 18.

Colorado's Gift of Music- A Piano Giveaway Event!

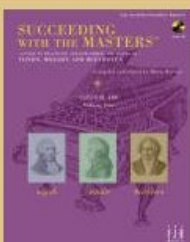
